Daiichi Surrenders Ranbaxy to Sun Pharma after Losing 38% Value, US Cracks Down on India Factories is Control Generics and ANDA



Indian billionaire Dilip Shanghvi's Sun Pharmaceutical Industries Ltd. (SUNP) is offering \$3.2 billion in stock to add Ranbaxy Laboratories Ltd. (RBXY)'s strength in emerging markets.

Sun Pharma also inherits regulatory troubles involving the U.S. market that Ranbaxy's current parent, Japan's Daiichi Sankyo Co., has struggled for more than five years to fix.

Gains from Yen Fall to 104 from 76 to the Dollar

Ranbaxy investors will get 0.8 share in Sun Pharma for every one of their shares, or about 457 rupees, about 24 percent higher than the 60-day average, the two companies said in a statement. Daiichi Sankyo, which owns 63.5 percent of Ranbaxy, paid 737 rupees a share in 2008. The dollar purchase was when the Yen was only 76 to the dollar. The sale is when the currency has fallen to 104. In balance Daiichi has gained 28 Yen on the \$4 bn sale to Sun Pharma.

Daiichi Sankyo on 6 April agreed to sell its controlling stake in Ranbaxy after taking writedowns on the Indian drugmaker and failing to raise manufacturing conditions to a level that would pass muster with the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. Four of Ranbaxy's plants are banned from exporting to the U.S. and the company has received a subpoena from the U.S. Attorney for the District of New Jersey requesting documents on one of those factories in India.

"The clear challenge will be some of Ranbaxy's manufacturing facilities which have FDA warnings," said Mahesh Patil, co-chief investment officer at Birla Sun Life Asset Management Co. in Mumbai, who manages about \$2.5 billion in equities. "Sun is going to have to work to get clearances through."

U.S. Sales

Getting Ranbaxy's factories up to speed would help Sun Pharma bolster its presence in the U.S., where Ranbaxy's lineup of drugs including the acne medicine Absorica and the generic version of Pfizer Inc.'s Lipitor. In March, the FDA said Ranbaxy was recalling some batches of the copycat cholesterol-lowering medicine.

Sun Pharma had its own cephalosporin facility in Gujarat banned from exporting to the U.S., according to a posting last month on the FDA's website. The company said in a statement the impact of the import alert on its consolidated revenues would be "negligible."

Caraco Pharmaceutical Laboratories Ltd., a Detroit-based unit of Sun Pharma, made 33 drugs including common blood pressure pills and pain killers until June 2009, when the FDA ordered manufacturing to be halted and U.S. marshals seized products made at the plant, citing "continued failure to meet current Good Manufacturing Practice requirements." Three years later, the

FDA cleared the unit to resume operations with two products.

Regulatory Experience

That experience may help Sun Pharma expedite the resolution of Ranbaxy's FDA issues, Patil said.

Daiichi Sankyo's difficulties in fixing Ranbaxy show the hurdles facing Sun. Three months after Daiichi Sankyo agreed to buy the controlling stake in Ranbaxy, the FDA barred imports from the Indian drugmaker's Paonta Sahib and Dewas plants because of manufacturing defects. In May 2009, Daiichi Sankyo posted a record full-year loss because of a writedown of the value of its controlling stake in Ranbaxy.

Daiichi Sankyo aims to recover losses from Ranbaxy through the transaction, Joji Nakayama, the Japanese company's chief executive officer, said at a briefing in Tokyo on 6 April. The company will own about 9 percent of Sun Pharma after the stock swap.

Daiichi has agreed to indemnify Sun Pharma and Ranbaxy for "among other things, certain costs and expenses that may arise from the subpoena," according to statement. The deal will take about nine months to complete, according to Sun Pharma's Baldota.

Emerging Markets

About one-third of Ranbaxy's revenue comes from emerging markets other than India.

Sun Pharma, founded by billionaire Shanghvi in 1983, has drugs in areas including psychiatry, neurology, cardiology and nephrology. Buying Ranbaxy will help Sun Pharma grow in markets such as Russia, Romania, South Africa, Brazil and Malaysia, according to an investor presentation.

The company in its annual report said its "focus markets for the future" would include Latin America, Russia, China and South Africa.

U.S. Generics

The deal will also give Sun Pharma access to three major products that Ranbaxy has tentative FDA approval to sell in the U.S.: generics of Novartis AG (NOVN)'s blockbuster Diovan, AstraZeneca Plc (AZN)'s Nexium and Roche Holding AG (ROG)'s Valcyte. Since Ranbaxy was first to file applications for the three products, it's entitled to 180 days of exclusivity if given final regulatory clearance.

Including the assumption of debt, the Ranbaxy transaction was valued at \$4 billion. Sun Pharma, maker of generic drugs including copies of Eli Lilly & Co.'s Cymbalta and Johnson & Johnson (JNJ)'s Doxil, expects \$250 million in revenue and reduced costs by the third year after completing the deal, according to the statement.

WTO Upholds NME Discrimination against China in US Law

A WTO panel has granted a mixed victory to Washington in its dispute with Beijing over the use of trade remedies, finding that a 2012 law allowing the US to impose anti-subsidy tariffs on non-market economies was in line with international trade rules. (DS 449)

At issue in the case was a bill passed by the US Congress in March 2012 that essentially preserved the Commerce Department's authority to impose anti-subsidy tariffs - known formally as countervailing duties (CVD) - on subsidised goods from non-market economies (NMEs), such as China and Vietnam.

The legislation, which was also designed to apply retroactively, overrode a 2011 federal court ruling which held that US law did not permit such a practice. Beijing filed a WTO challenge shortly thereafter, objecting to the lack of transparency and due process in the enactment of the law.

The dispute panel ultimately found that the 2012 law did not bring about an increase in rates of countervailing duties on imports from China as an NME country, or impose a new restriction on those imports.

Furthermore, recognising that the 2012 law - as the US states - "ensured" the 2011 court ruling would "never have any effect under US law," the panel found that the WTO provision raised by China does not prohibit a member from taking such legislative action.

China's classification as an NME has long been a source of frustration between Beijing and some of its major trading partners, particularly the US and EU. Under WTO rules, goods from non-market economies can be treated differently when calculating anti-dumping duties, which are meant to counter instances where products are sold overseas below cost.

Double Duty of Anti-dumping + Anti Subsidy CVD Not Allowed

In these calculations, the US uses a surrogate

country to determine what constitutes a "normal" market price for the goods in question, on the grounds that Chinese prices are distorted by government involvement in the market.

In some instances, however, certain calculation methodologies can lead to the imposition of so-called double remedies, in which both anti-dumping and countervailing duties are being applied on the same product, if the subsidies being targeted by the latter duties are also responsible in part for the dumping.

The panel found that the US had failed to investigate whether such double remedies arose from 25 CVD and anti-dumping proceedings, initiated over the period 2006-2012, involving certain goods from China.

Citing a previous Appellate Body decision on anti-dumping duties and CVDs (DS379), the panel said that these double remedies can also refer to "double counting," and may therefore contravene global trade rules.

The exports targeted in those specific trade investigations included Chinese exports of paper, steel, tyres, magnets, chemicals, kitchen appliances, wood flooring, and wind towers, which Beijing officials say were worth over US\$7.2 billion annually.

Beijing welcomed the finding on double remedies, urging Washington to "correct the erroneous practice of abusing trade remedy measures as soon as possible."

Washington officials, meanwhile, have said that the Department of Commerce will review any possible overlap of countervailing and anti-dumping duties, while noting that the panel's concerns deal with past determinations that were made before the 2012 law came into effect.

The 2012 law included language aimed at resolving the double remedy problem, specifically by requiring that the price margins used for calculating anti-dumping duties be adjusted in instances where the import's low price is due partly to a subsidy.



Xi Visits Brussels, may Join WTO TiSA Negotiations



The EU and China agreed on Monday to consider the possibility of a bilateral trade pact, should their current negotiations for an investment deal prove fruitful. The announcement came as part of Chinese President Xi Jinping's high-profile visit to Brussels, which also saw the EU publicly support Beijing's bid for joining talks on a plurilateral deal in services trade.

The summit showed a marked change in tone from the bilateral trade tensions seen in recent years, which saw the two sides spar heatedly over topics ranging from support of their renewable energy sectors to trade in wine and telecommunications products.

The trip also marked Xi's first visit to Brussels since assuming his country's top leadership position a year ago, and also the first time a leader from the Asian economic powerhouse has visited the EU institutions since diplomatic relations were established in 1975.

EU, China: investment talks could open FTA door

The EU and China made headlines last year when they agreed to negotiate a sweeping bilateral investment pact, and have held two rounds of talks so far, with the latest one occurring the week before the high-level summit.

The level of foreign investment between the two sides is famously low, particularly when compared to their trading relationship. According to European Commission data, China accounts for 2-3 percent of EU investments abroad, while Chinese investments in the 28-country bloc are even lower.

While the investment talks could in themselves yield substantial gains to both economies, trade observers have also noted the potential that such a pact might have in paving the way for a bilateral free trade agreement (FTA) in the long-term.

Trade flows between the two sides already surpass over €1 billion daily, making the EU China's biggest trading partner. China, mean-

while, is Europe's second-largest trading partner after the US.

The push by Xi for an EU-China deal - which could have a market of 2 billion consumers - comes at a time when so-called mega-regional trade pacts have become increasingly commonplace. China is not currently involved in either the 12-country Trans-Pacific Partnership talks, nor the US-EU Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership, and many analysts have questioned whether such initiatives are an effort by advanced economies to partly counter Beijing's growing economic weight.

EU backs China entry into TiSA talks

In another victory for China, Brussels also declared on Monday that it will be backing Beijing's bid to join the Trade in Services Agreement (TiSA), a plurilateral negotiation among a subset of the WTO's membership that aims to liberalise services trade.

China declared its interest in the services talks late last year, despite having earlier been sceptical of such plurilateral initiatives. However, some current TiSA participants have reportedly questioned whether China indeed shares their level of ambition, particularly given the Asian economy's role in last year's breakdown of a separate set of negotiations on expanding the WTO Information Technology Agreement.

Brakes on Aussie-Japanese Trade Deal Over Auto and Agro Tariffs

Australia's bid to reach a trade deal with Japan during Prime Minister Tony Abbott's North Asia visit next week is being jeopardized by a disagreement over agricultural and car tariffs, Trade Minister Andrew Robb said.

The free-trade talks are stuck on the issue of Japanese tariffs on beef and dairy imports, and Australian duties on car imports, Robb said in a phone interview from Melbourne today. Failure to sign an initial deal when Abbott meets with Prime Minister Shinzo Abe April 7 would be "unfortunate," he said.

Japan is Australia's second-largest trading partner with two-way trade of items including coal, iron ore, copper and beef worth A\$69.2 billion (\$63.9 billion) in 2012-13, according to government figures. Abbott, whose Liberal-National coalition won office in September, will sign a trade agreement with South Korea during his trip and attempt to progress negotiations with China, Australia's biggest trading partner.

China Deal

The talks with China are more technical than those with Japan and South Korea as there are 11,000 tariff lines that need to be agreed upon. Sticking points include China's concerns over investment and labor mobility, while Australia is keen for progress on agricultural and services issues, he said.

Australia, which will cease making automobiles by 2017 as Toyota Motor Corp., Ford Motor Co. and General Motors Co. shutter plants, wants to protect its 700 car-component makers, Robb said. Japan's exports of passenger motor vehicles to Australia totaled A\$6.8 billion in the 12 months to the end of last June, according to government figures.

Pharma and Drug Consignment Exports Permitted thru Self-Certification Process

Compliance of Barcoding Requirement on Secondary and Tertiary Level Packaging w.e.f. 1 April 2014

Sub: Self-certification regarding compliance of bar-coding requirements on secondary and tertiary level packaging on export consignment of pharmaceuticals and drugs.

56-PN(RE) In exercise of the powers
01.04.2014 conferred under Paragraph 2.4
(DGFT) of the Foreign Trade Policy,
2009-14, Director General of

Foreign Trade hereby prescribes the procedure for self-certification regarding compliance of bar-coding requirements on secondary and tertiary level packaging on export consignment of pharmaceuticals and drugs.

2. Bar-coding on tertiary level packaging has come into effect from 1st October, 2011 as per Public Notice No. 59 of 30.06.2011. Similarly on secondary level packaging this has come into effect from 1st January, 2013 as per Public Notice No. 10 of 11.07.2012. The requirement of bar-coding on primary level packaging will come into effect from 1st July, 2014.

3. It has been decided that with effect from 01.04.2014, export of pharmaceuticals and drug consignment would be permitted through a self-certification process. In this process, the exporters would be required to furnish a written declaration to the custom authorities at the time of export [as per Annexure to this public notice] regarding compliance of the relevant provisions of bar-coding on secondary and tertiary level packaging on the consignment of pharmaceuticals and drugs being exported.

3. Effect of this Public Notice

A self-certification process on compliance of bar-coding requirement on secondary and tertiary level packaging of pharmaceuticals and drugs has been introduced. This will be effective from 1st April, 2014

Robusta Exports Drop 10% as Heavy Rains Shrink Harvest

Coffee shipments from India, Asia's third-largest grower, are poised to fall this year as a rally in global prices deters buyers from Italy to Russia and after unseasonal rains cut output for the first time in six years.

Exports may decline as much as 10 percent from 312,756 metric tons in 2013, said Ramesh Rajah, president of the Coffee Exporters Association of India. The harvest probably dropped below 300,000 tons in the 12 months started Oct. 1 from a record 318,200 tons a year earlier, he said.

Reduced supplies from India, where robusta accounts for 70 percent of output, may help a surge in prices of the beans used by Nestle SA in instant drinks. Futures of the arabica variety, brewed by specialty companies including Starbucks Corp., advanced in New York to a two-year high in March and robusta in London jumped 20 percent this year as drought threatened crops in Brazil, the largest producer and exporter.

Robusta added 0.1 percent to \$2,014 a ton on NYSE Liffe on 2 April. Arabica rose 1.1 percent to \$1.746 a pound on ICE Futures U.S. after reaching a two-year high of \$2.0975 in March.

The state-run Coffee Board cut its crop estimate for 2013-2014 to 311,500 tons in January from a record 347,000 tons predicted at the start of the season, citing heavy rains in the Karnataka region, which represents about 70 percent of output.
