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India - Malaysia Implements CECA from 1 July 2011

The India-Malaysia Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Agreement (CECA) will come into effect on 1 July 2011. India-Malaysia CECA is India's fourth bilateral Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Agreement, after Singapore, South Korea and Japan. The CECA envisages liberalisation of trade in goods, trade in services, investments and other areas of economic cooperation.

Trade between India and Malaysia has reached US\$ 10 billion in 2010-11, an increase of 26% from the previous year. It is expected that the implementation of this agreement will boost bilateral trade to US\$15 billion by 2015.

The trade in goods package under India-Malaysia CECA takes the tariff liberalization beyond the India-ASEAN FTA commitments, which were implemented by both countries on 1 January 2010. Under India-Malaysia CECA, the items on which India has obtained market access from Malaysia include basmati rice, mangoes, eggs, trucks, motorcycles and cotton garments, which are all items of considerable export interest to India. At the same time, adequate protection has been provided by the Indian side for sensitive sectors such as agriculture, fisheries, textiles, chemicals, auto, etc.

Under the services agreement of the CECA, India and Malaysia have provided commercially meaningful commit-

ments in sectors and modes of interest to each other which should result in enhanced services trade. The CECA also facilitates the temporary movement of business people including contractual service suppliers, and independent professionals in commercially meaningful sectors including accounting and auditing, architecture, urban planning, engineering services, medical and dental, nursing and pharmacy, Computer and Related Services (CRS), and Management Consulting Services.

The India-Malaysia CECA also facilitates cross-border investments between the two countries. It aims to promote investments and create a liberal, facilitative, transparent and competitive investment regime. The CECA creates an attractive operating environment for the business communities of both countries to increase bilateral trade and investment.

WTO Bolsters Complaints Over China Exports



Complaints against China by the U.S., European Union and Mexico were bolstered by a World Trade Organization finding that the nation's limits on raw-materials exports broke global rules and gave domestic companies an edge.

The ruling on 4 July on the Geneva-based trade arbiter's website was after an 18-month investigation of quotas, export duties and license requirements. China said it was evaluating the report. An appeal is highly likely, Mei Xinyu, a professor at a government trade institute, said on 5 July.

The restrictions have stoked tensions between China and its trading partners and boosted raw-material prices. The ruling may encourage the U.S. and the EU to now target Chinese restraints on rare earths, a group of 17 elements used in wind turbines, hybrid cars and guided missiles.

The finding is "a significant victory for manufacturers and workers in the U.S. and the rest of the world," U.S. Trade Representative Ron Kirk said in an e-mail. The duties "have caused massive distortions and harmful disruptions in supply

chains throughout the global marketplace."

The commodities at stake in the decision included magnesium, manganese, silicon carbide, fluorspar, silicon carbide and yellow phosphorus, used by the steel, aluminum, automotive and chemicals industries.

'Expected to Appeal'

Mei, of the Chinese Academy of International Trade and Economic Cooperation, said "there's a 95 percent chance China will appeal." He was speaking in a phone interview in Beijing.

China is studying the report and will follow up as appropriate, the Ministry of Commerce said on 5 July, adding that the government "feels regret" at the findings.

China, the world's second-largest economy, is the top producer of cadmium, gold, indium, iron ore, lime, lead, manganese, mercury, molybdenum, phosphate, salt, tin, tungsten, vanadium and zinc.

"The panel found that China's export duties were inconsistent with the commitments that China had agreed to in its Protocol of Accession," WTO judges said in a summary of a 315-page ruling. "Export quotas imposed by China on some of the raw materials were inconsistent with WTO rules."

Natural Resources

China said the restrictions are necessary to conserve exhaustible natural resources and ease overproduction and emissions of carbon and sulfur gases from furnaces. The U.S., the EU and Mexico said the curbs discourage the export of materials that are critical for their manufacturers, while keeping them cheaper and readily available in China.

The WTO panel said that China was "unable to demonstrate" that the export duties curtailed pollution. China's government has the right to appeal the decision.

U.S. Senator Max Baucus, a Montana Democrat, called on China to end the export limits.

Rare Earths

Chinese limits have triggered sixfold increases in prices for some rare earths, souring ties with users including the U.S. and Japan. The government may further reduce quotas, pushing prices higher, Goldman Sachs & Partners Australia Pty said in May.

China, supplier of 95 percent of global rare earths, has said the curbs protect the environment and meet its WTO commitments. The country's Inner Mongolia Baotou region produces so-called light rare earths such as lanthanum, cerium and samarium. Heavy rare-earth production, mostly in southern China, includes the elements dysprosium, gadolinium and terbium.

Dollar Exports Up by 56.93% in May 2011

Exports (including re-exports)

India's Exports during May, 2011 were valued at US \$ 25941.28 million (Rs. 116488.01 crore) which was 56.93 per cent higher in Dollar terms (53.82 per cent higher in Rupee terms) than the level of US \$ 16530.85 million (Rs. 75730.31 crore) during May, 2010. Cumulative value of exports for the period April-May 2011 -12 was US \$ 49790.60 million (Rs 222307.44 crore) as against US \$ 34272.98 million (Rs154681.89 crore) registering a growth of 45.28 per cent in Dollar terms and 43.72 per cent in Rupee terms over the same period last year.

Imports

India's Imports during May, 2011 were valued at US \$ 40906.95 million (Rs.183690.60 crore) representing a growth of 54.08 per cent in Dollar terms (51.03 per cent in Rupee terms) over the level of imports valued at US \$ 26549.51 million (Rs. 121627.30 crore) in May, 2010. Cumulative value of imports for the period April-May, 2011-12 was US \$ 73741.31 million (Rs. 329376.66 crore) as against US \$ 55319.57 million (Rs. 249652.61 crore) registering a growth of 33.30 per cent in Dollar terms and 31.93 per cent in Rupee terms over the same period last year.

Crude Oil and Non-Oil Imports

Oil imports during May, 2011 were valued at US \$ 10161.0 million which was 18.57 per cent higher than oil imports valued at US \$ 8570.0 million in the corresponding period last year. Oil imports during April-May, 2011-12 were valued at US\$ 20347.0 million which was 12.89 per cent higher than the oil imports of US \$ 18024.0

million in the corresponding period last year.

Non-oil imports during May, 2011 were estimated at US \$ 30745.8 million which was 71.0 per cent higher than non-oil imports of US \$ 17979.5 million in May, 2010. Non-oil imports during April - May, 2011-12 were valued at US\$ 53394.2 million which was 43.17 per cent higher than the level of such imports valued at US\$ 37295.5 million in April - May, 2010-11.

Trade Balance

The trade deficit for April - May, 2011-12 was estimated at US \$ 23950.71 million which was lower than the deficit of US \$ 21046.59 million during April -May, 2010-11.

- Financial sector reforms, including deepening of capital markets, financial inclusion, and ensuring the stability, transparency, and integrity of the financial system.
- Infrastructure finance, including innovative strategies to mobilize capital for infrastructure development, and sharing best practices and building capacity for design and successful execution of Public Private Partnerships.

Euro Gains on Bets European Central Bank to Raise Rates; Baht Strengthens

The euro rose to three-week highs versus the dollar and yen on speculation the European Central Bank will increase interest rates this week after the region rescued debt-stricken Greece from the brink of default.

The shared currency gained against 12 of its 16 major counterparts after European finance ministers authorized an 8.7 billion-euro (\$12.7 billion) loan payout to Greece by mid-July. Thailand's baht rose after an election victory by allies of former premier Thaksin Shinawatra spurred optimism that foreign investors will return. Australia's dollar weakened after reports showed retail sales and building approvals fell.

The euro rose to \$1.4563 from \$1.4526 in New York last week, after advancing to \$1.4578, the strongest since June 9. The currency climbed 0.2 percent to 117.63 yen, after appreciating to 117.74 yen, the highest since June 8. The dollar traded at 80.78 yen from 80.83 yen.

The Dollar Index, which tracks the greenback against the currencies of six major U.S. trading partners, fell 0.2 percent to 74.158 after

Subject: Clarification regarding import of Fuel under Advance Authorisation / DFIA Scheme.

33-Pol.Cir Attention is invited to the
01.07.2011 General Note for Fuel
(DGFT) specified in the HBP v2.
The General Note was further amended by Public Notice No. 66/2009-14 dated 19.5.2010. The amendment allowed import of fuel even for Adhoc Norms cases under Paragraph 4.7 of Handbook of Procedures, v1.

2. It has been brought to the notice of this Directorate that the applicability of this provision is also made in cases where 'Fuel' is being used as a main raw material for manufacturing export product and in such cases the import entitlement is determined as per the 'General Note for Fuel'.

3. In this regard, the following is clarified:-

(i) The General Note for Fuel has been incorporated in view of provisions at para 4.1.3 of FTP which allows fuel as an additional input to obtain export product.

(ii) In cases where fuel is used as a single input or basic raw material and not as an additional input to the export product, the entitlement shall not be as per the General Note for Fuel. Rather the import entitlement will be either as per SION, if it exists or in non-SION cases, an applicant can seek the inputs in terms of para 4.7 of the HBP v1 and the final adjustment will be made as per adhoc / SION fixed by Norms Committee.

Cotton Waste Contract Registration with DGFT – 45 Days for Shipment Allowed

Subject: Conditions and modalities for registration of contracts of cotton waste including yarn waste and garneted stock [ITC(HS) Code 5202] with DGFT.

34-Pol.Cir Notification No. 57 (RE-2010)/01.07.2011 2009-14 dated 09.06.2011 has (DGFT) raised the cap on export of cotton for the cotton season

2010-11 (upto 30.09.2011) to 65 lakh bales, thereby allowing export of additional 10 lakh bales of cotton, upto 30.09.2011. Through Notification No. (RE-2010)/2009-14 dated .06.2011, it has been notified that the cap of additional 10 lakh bales, on export of cotton during the cotton season 2010-11 (upto 30.09.2011), will apply only to Tariff codes 5201 and 5203. This cap shall not apply to export of cotton waste including yarn waste and garneted stock(Tariff code 5202).

2. Thus, Export of cotton waste including yarn waste and garneted stock [ITC(HS) Code 5202] is "Free" subject to registration of export contracts with DGFT. Procedure for registration of contracts for export of cotton waste including yarn waste and garneted stock(Tariff code 5202), which are to be registered with the Regional Authorities of DGFT, is described below. This is similar to Policy Circular No. 27 of 01.04.2011 relating to export of cotton yarn except that period of shipment against the RCs will be 45 days for export of cotton waste. It is 30 days for export of cotton yarn.

3. All applications for grant of registration certificate shall be submitted to the concerned RAs alongwith the following documents:

- (i) Copy of Export Contract alongwith,
 - (a) A copy of irrevocable Letter of Credit(LC) duly authenticated by an Indian Bank, or
 - (b) FIRC from Bank showing receipt of remittance from the concerned foreign buyer as

proof of having received 100% Advance Payment or

(c) a minimum of 25% Advance Payment and balance Cash Against Delivery(CAD).

(ii) Declaration/Undertaking as given in Annexure-I of this Policy Circular, on the letter head of the firm.

(iii) Copy of IEC

4. If the documents received are found in order, the applicant shall be issued a Registration Certificate. Export against this registration certificate shall be completed within a period of 45 days from the date of issuance of such certificate. The firms would be required to submit proof of export to the concerned RA within 10 days of last shipment.

5. Failure to export the allowed quantity within the stipulated time would invite debarment from further registration. In addition, penal action as per Section 11(2) of the Foreign Trade (D&R) Act would be initiated. For ready reference Section 11(2) is extracted below:-

"11(2). Where any person makes or abets or attempts to make any export or import in contravention of any provisions of this Act or any rules or order made thereunder or the Foreign Trade Policy, he shall be liable to a penalty of not less than ten thousand rupees and not more than five times the value of the goods or services or technology in respect of which any contravention is made or attempted to be made, whichever is more."

6. This issues with the approval of Director General of Foreign Trade.

Cap of 10 Lakh Bales is not Applicable to Cotton Waste Exports

Subject: Exemption for export of cotton waste including yarn waste and garneted stock [ITC (HS) Code 5202] from the quantity restriction on export of cotton during Cotton Season, 2010-11.

58-Ntfn(RE) In exercise of the powers 01.07.2011 conferred by Section 5 of (DGFT) the Foreign Trade (Development &

Regulation) Act, 1992 (No.22 of 1992) read with Para 2.1 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2009-14, the Central Government hereby amends Notification No. 57 (RE-2010)/2009-14 dated 09.06.2011 read with Notification No. 32(RE-2010)/2009-14 dated 14.03.2011 and Notification No. 12(RE-2010)/2009-14 dated 16.12.2010.

2. Notification No. 12(RE-2010)/2009-14 dated 16.12.2010 stipulated that export of cotton under chapter 52, serial number 161 A (Tariff codes 5201, 5202 and 5203) of ITC (HS) classification of export and import items, will be "free". In this notification, nature of restrictions against all the three codes was that "the contracts for export of cotton shall be registered with the Directorate General of Foreign Trade prior to shipment. Clearance of cotton consignments by customs should be after verifying that the contracts have been registered". The "Nature of Restrictions" as appearing in Notification No. 12(RE-2010)/2009-14 dated 16.12.2010 was amended through Notification No. 32(RE-2010)/2009-14 dated 14.03.2011. In the nature of restrictions it was added that export of cotton for the cotton season 2010-11 (upto 30.09.2011) will be subject to a cap of 55 lakh bales or as notified by DGFT from time to time. Subsequently, through Notification No. 57 (RE-2010)/2009-14 dated 09.06.2011, the cap on export of cotton for the cotton season 2010-11 (upto 30.09.2011) was raised to 65 lakh bales, thereby allowing export of additional 10 lakh bales of cotton, upto 30.09.2011.

3. It has been decided that the cap of additional 10 lakh bales, on export of cotton during the cotton season 2010-11 (upto 30.09.2011), will apply only to Tariff codes 5201 and 5203. This cap shall not apply to export of cotton waste including yarn waste and garneted stock(Tariff code 5202).

4. The effect of this notification:
Cap of 10 lakh bales will not be applicable to export of cotton waste including yarn waste and garneted stock [ITC(HS) Code 5202]. However, condition regarding registration of contracts with DGFT will continue to apply.

operational guidelines of the MOU.

3. Vendors who are allowed to sell their prod-
ucts in the Border Haats shall be the residents
of the area within five (5) km radius from the
location of Border Haat. The vendees may offer
immediate consumption items of snack foods/
juices as may be allowed by the Haat Manage-
ment Committee.

Board Asks Airport Customs for Vigilance on Suspicious Passengers and Baggage Valuation

[Ref: F.No. 520/14/2011-Cus.VI dated 1 July 2011]

Subject: Issues relating to Customs clearance at International Airports in India

Attention is invited to Notification No.74/2005-
Customs (N.T.) & 75/2005-Customs (N.T.) both
dated 30.8.2005 under Import Manifest (Air-
craft) Regulations, 1976 and Export Manifest
(Aircraft) Regulations, 1976, as amended, re-
spectively. The former notification mandates
that passenger manifest shall be delivered elec-
tronically within 15 minutes of the closure and
departure of flights from the originating station
while the latter notification requires that the
passenger manifest shall be delivered elec-
tronically to Customs three hours before the
departure of the flight.

2. It has been brought to the notice of the
Board that advance information of passenger
manifest transmitted by Airlines to Customs is
not properly collated and used for mapping and
profiling of passengers who are short visitors /
frequent visitors or against whom offence cases
have been registered in the past. This informa-
tion is also not systematically utilized in cases
where alerts have been issued by DRI, SIIB or
other investigating agencies for monitoring and
apprehending the targets.

3. Board has taken a serious note of the
aforementioned matter and emphasizes the
urgent need to put in place a mechanism to
gather intelligence and undertake profiling of
suspect international passengers. The advance
details available in the passenger manifest cur-
rently delivered by airlines to Customs in terms
of Notification No.74/2005-Customs (NT) and
No.75/2005-Customs (NT) both dated 30.8.2005
contain details like name of passenger and
passport number which can be matched with
available data for monitoring of alert issued by

DGRI / SIIB or other agencies and available with
Customs. Board also directs that suitable com-
puterized database of frequent / short visitors
should be forthwith developed at all interna-
tional airports.

4. Board is also concerned about the lack of
computerized database of offence cases regis-
tered against erring passengers at international
airports. Only at Chennai international airport,
a customized software namely COPS is being
used for maintaining and updating an offender
database. The lack of database has resulted in
inadequate compliance of Board's instructions
relating to identification of repeat offenders for
deciding fitness for arrest and launch of pros-
ecution. Further, unavailability of ready and
easy-to-use database on habitual offenders
leaves enough scope to adjudicate the cases of
non-bonafide baggage with nominal fine and
penalty by Customs authorities.

In this regard, it is appropriate to reiterate that
Board has instructed in the past that cases of
import of goods in commercial quantities through
passenger baggage should be adjudicated by
imposing appropriate fine and penalty so as to
curtail this practice. Board, therefore, desires
that concerned Commissioners at international
airports should immediately explore the feasi-
bility of replicating COPS software to their air-
ports, in consultation with DG (System), New
Delhi.

5. It is also reported that there are cases of
considerable variation in assessed value of
similar goods at airports. Further, the same
items are being assessed to different values at
different airports. This varying practice of as-
sessment has adverse implications for rev-

92-PN It has been observed that,
02.06.2011 renewed/extended Bank
Guarantees (BGs) are being
forwarded to this Commissionerate directly
by various banks under cover of a letter
addressed to the President of India. Com-
missioner Customs, JNCH. In the absence of
Reference/file no of the concerned section,
precious time is lost in trying to locate the
section to which the BG on the said exten-
sion/renewal letter is meant to be delivered to.
There are various Sections in this
Commissionerate like Groups, Bond Depart-
ment, No ting Section etc. where the Bonds
along with Bank Guarantees are accepted.
Although the above said letters mention the
name of the Applicant, it is insufficient to
associate the Bg with the respective Section
where it is required to be sent for follow up. It
has been noticed that in the absence of
correct/specific reference, the assessment
process or enforcement in case of default, is
delayed.

2. To mitigate the problem and to help in
speedier updation of details, it has been
decided that on the request of the applicant,
whenever any Bank Guarantee or its re-
newal/extension letter is issued, it should
mention relevant file number/section/group
of the custom House. To ensure this, the
importer or his representative at the time of
application to Bank should mention the name
of relevant section/group for incorporation of
the same by the concerned Bank on the
communication regarding Bank Guarantee
or renewal/extension of Bank Guarantee.

3. Difficulties, if any, faced in the imple-
mentation of this public notice may be brought
to the notice of the undersigned.

Subject: Procedure relating to export of pharmaceuticals and drugs.

2004-2009, as amended from

time to time, Director General of Foreign Trade, notifies with immediate effect, procedures/guidelines to strengthen the enforcement mechanism available under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 to ensure that counterfeit drugs do not get exported out of the country.



2. Procedure for export of Drugs & Pharmaceuticals, covered under the provisions of Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 and the rules made there under, shall be as given below:

3. Every exporter of Drugs & Pharmaceuticals

at the time of shipment shall submit, along with other required documents, the following:

(i) A copy of Certificate of Analysis issued by the manufacturer for the subject product; or

(ii) A copy of Certificate of Analysis issued by approved laboratory of the importing country/FDA; or

(iii) A copy of Certificate of Analysis issued by a laboratory approved by Drugs Controller under Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 and the rules made there under.

4. Wherever required the officials of the Drug Control Department posted at the port offices may retain a sample of the subject consignment for the purpose of reference and tracking of the manufacturer / exporter of the subject product.

Implementation of Barcoding of Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Export Consignments

Sub: Deferment in the date of effect for implementation of bar-coding on export consignment of pharmaceuticals and drugs for tracing and tracking purpose.

time to time, Director General of Foreign Trade hereby amends Public Notice No. 21 dated 10th January, 2011 and prescribes the following procedure for tracing and tracking of export consignments of pharmaceutical products.

2. (i) Exporters of pharmaceutical products will adopt a trace and track system and incorporate its features for exported medicines using barcode technology as per GS 1 global standards as detailed below:

a. Primary Level packaging requirement: Incorporation of 2D (GS1 Data matrix) barcodes on medicines at strip/vial/bottle, etc. encoding unique product identification code (GTIN) and

Unique Serial Number of the Primary pack.

b. Secondary Level packaging requirement: Incorporation of barcodes (1D or 2D) encoding unique product identification code (GTIN), Batch Number, Expiry Date and Unique Serial Number of the Secondary pack.

c. Tertiary Level packaging requirement: Incorporation of barcodes (1D) encoding unique product identification code (GTIN), Batch Number, Expiry Date and Unique Serial Number of the Tertiary pack (shipper/carton).

(ii) The trace and track technology as per serial number 2(i) above will come into effect as follows:

(a) Primary Level - With effect from 1st packaging July, 2012

(b) Secondary Level - With effect from 1st packaging January, 2012

Second Hand Computers Import Requires Permission from MoEF

Subject: Import of hazardous waste under Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary) Rules, 2008

27-CBEC It is reported to the Board that
04.07.2011 e-wastes such as used
(DoR) computers, CRT, RAM and
electrical and electronic

assemblies are being dumped in a big way into the country thereby posing serious threat to environment. References have also been received seeking clarification whether used computers imported for re-use need permission of Ministry of Environment and Forest before clearance.

2. As the field formations are aware, the import and export of hazardous wastes is regulated by the Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary) Rules, 2008. Chapter IV of these Rules deals with import and export of hazardous wastes and Rule 13 thereof states that import of such wastes shall be allowed only for recycling, or recovery or reuse and not for disposal. Further, Rule 14 thereof provides that import and export of hazardous wastes specified in Schedule III shall be regulated in accor-

dance with the conditions specified therein. A perusal of the said Schedule III shows that entries at A1180 and B1110 are relevant for electrical and electronic assemblies.

3. In this regard, the administrative Ministry viz. Ministry of Environment and Forests has been consulted and they have confirmed that items at A1180 of the said Schedule III relating to waste electrical and electronic assemblies or scrap containing components such as accumulators and other batteries etc. require Prior informed Consent. It is also confirmed that items at B1110 of the said Schedule III can be imported with permission from Ministry of Environment and Forests. This entry includes electrical and electronic assemblies (including printed circuit board electronic components and wires) destined for direct re-use and not for recycling or final disposal. The Ministry of Environment and Forests has also confirmed that imports of second hand computers would require the per-

Amendments in Point of Taxation Rules 2011

41-ST In exercise of the powers
27.06.2011 conferred by clause (a) and
(DoR) clause (hhh) of sub-section
(2) of section 94 of the

Finance Act, 1994 (32 of 1994), the Central Government, on being satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest so to do, hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Point of Taxation Rules, 2011, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Point of Taxation (Second Amendment) Rules, 2011.

(2) They shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 2011.

2. In the Point of Taxation Rules, 2011, in Rule 7, in sub-rule (c),-

before the bracket and letter "(p)", the bracket and letter "(g)" shall be inserted, [F. No. 334/3/2011-TRU]

(c) Tertiary Level - With effect from 1st packaging October, 2011

3. In case the importing country has mandated a specific requirement, the exporter can adhere to the same and it would not be necessary to comply with the stipulations at serial number a, b & c of para 2 above.

4. Under the track and trace system, manufacturers would be required to maintain serialized record of exported pharmaceutical products for a minimum period of six months after the expiry date of the product.

5. Authentication features will be added in due course and integrated with the trace and track system.

6. Government will set up a Central Portal for tracing and tracking exported pharmaceutical products.

7. Effect of this Public Notice

Earlier the requirement of affixing barcodes was to come into effect from 01.07.2011. Now more time is being allowed.

4. In view of the above, the Board desires that the field formations should carefully and strictly implement the provisions of Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary) Rules, 2008. In particular, it should be noted that all imported goods falling within the purview of entry B 1110 of Part B of Schedule III of the said Rules, indicating second hand computers, would require the permission of the Ministry of Environment and Forests for import into India. It merits mention that the field formations should also refer to Rule 17 of the said Rules that treats contravening imports as illegal traffic requiring the importer to re-export the wastes at his cost within 90 days from the date of arrival. We must ensure that India does not become a destination for dumping junk electronic products.

5. These instructions may be brought the notice of all concerned by way of issuance of a suitable Public Notice/Standing Order.

6. Difficulties, if any, in implementation of these instructions may be immediately brought to the notice of the Board.

ECB Rates

The ECB on July 7 will increase its benchmark rate to 1.5 percent from 1.25 percent. The central bank will raise its target rate by 77 basis points over the next 12 months, a Credit Suisse AG index showed, compared with a prediction for 43 basis points of increases a week ago.

European officials agreed on July 2 to make the payout to Greece after the nation's parliament passed austerity measures. Finance chiefs gather next week to discuss a long-term lifeline for Greece.

The euro has strengthened 0.4 percent over the past week against a basket of nine developed-market peers. The yen has dropped 1.5 percent and the dollar has weakened 1.7 percent.

Baht Gains

The baht strengthened against all of its major counterparts on speculation the decisive election win by Thaksin's allies will bring stability to the nation. Clashes between his supporters and opponents have claimed more than 100 lives since the previous poll in 2007.

The baht rose 1.2 percent to 30.45 per dollar, after climbing to 30.41, the strongest level since June 23. Credit Agricole predicts the baht will advance to 29.20 by year-end.
