supplementing Regulation (EU) 2024/1157 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 April 2024 on shipments of waste by establishing a list of countries to which the OECD Decision does not apply and to which exports of certain non-hazardous wastes and mixtures of non-hazardous wastes from the Union for recovery are authorised

ANNEX

List of countries to which exports are authorised

This Annex lays down the list of countries to which the OECD Decision does not apply and to which exports of non-hazardous wastes and mixtures of non-hazardous wastes from the Union for recovery are authorised. The list specifies for each country the waste for which such exports are allowed as follows:

- the first column provides a general description of the waste concerned, whereas the second and third columns specify the type of waste in question, indicating the Basel/OECD entry¹;
- only waste that is covered by the code or codes in the second column, in combination with the detailed description in the third column, shall be considered as listed pursuant to Article 41 of Regulation (EU) 2024/1157;
- where two or more codes are mentioned together, the entry concerns waste covered by any of those codes;
- the fourth column specifies for each type of waste whether shipments of the waste concerned are subject to the prior notification and consent procedure as indicated by the respective countries in their request and in accordance with Article 40(3) of Regulation (EU) 2024/1157. When the waste shipment is not subject to the prior notification and consent procedure, the general information requirements laid down in Article 18 of Regulation (EU) 2024/1157 shall apply;
- the Commission shall make available on its website a list of facilities which are licensed under the domestic legislation of each country to carry out the recovery of the waste listed in this Annex.
