Sub: Scanning of export documents filed at Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai

The Customs Export Commissionerate at Air Cargo Complex, Sahar Mumbai had stopped the task of collecting, scanning and safe custody of documents pertaining to exports taking place at ACC Mumbai w.e.f. 1st April 2020 due to introduction of E-Sanchit for Export.

2. It is observed that majority of exporters are not uploading many of the documents related to exports in the E-Sanchit portal. Also, the uploading of export related documents in E-Sanchit has not yet been made mandatory in the Exports.

3. It may however be noted that exporters are uploading some of the documents in the EDI System like Invoice and Packing List at the time of filing the shipping bills. But, the exporters are not loading any of the following documents in the EDI system viz: Certificates, Permissions, Licenses and other NOC like;

- (i) Animal Quarantine and Health Certificate from Municipal Council of Greater Mumbai (MCGM) Certificate
- (ii) Health Certificate of Local Body from MCGM
- (iii) MPEDA and EIA (Export Inspection Agency) Certificate
- (iv) Health Certificate from MCGM
- (v) WLRO NOC
- (vi) Phytosanitary Certificate
- (vii) Horticulture Certificate
- (viii) Tea Board Certificate
- (ix) Spice Board Certificate
- (x) FSSAI NOC
- (xi) Tobacco Board Certificate
- (xii) Assistant Drug Controller NOC
- (xiii) BARC NOC
- (xiv) CBN Certificate from Gwalior
- (xv) Central Board of Film Certification NOC
- (xvi) Plant Quarantine NOC

(xvii) WLA Wool and Coarse Animal Hair NOC

(xviii) DGCA Permission and other similar certificates/NOCs.

4. These certificates and their originals are verified by the Customs Officers during the course of examination of export goods prior to grant of LEO. However, at that stage there is no facility to upload these documents either in EDI System or in E-Sanchit portal,. Some of these documents are quantity based (QABAL) and therefore these are required to be physically debited.

5. Therefore there is mandatory requirement to manage these documents for varying fixed length of time as they might be required for any post export proceedings/ enquiry/ investigation or any other follow up action.

6. In view of above, till the time uploading of these documents (Certificate, Licenses, Permissions/NOCs) is made mandatory, it would be in the interest of revenue to manage these documents. Hence, the documents management system undertaken by M/s. Newgen will be continued till further Notice. All Exports, Custom Brokers and other stakeholders are requested to co-operate and implement the above.
